

HISTORY AND PHYSICAL DISCHARGE SUMMARY

The patient has been in the hospital for approximately 5 days due to severe cold symptoms. The primary diagnosis was acute respiratory infection (ARI), while secondary pneumonia also emerged as a concern. The hospital course included supportive care, including antacrine and flu shots. Discharge diagnoses include ARI and pneumonia. Medications include flu shots, antacrine, and an IV for fever reduction. Follow-up instructions: visit in 7 days; cover all areas with clothing.
